Dear Community: Due to an increase in viable threats made by anti-LGBTQ+ hate groups in the Sacramento area, including those targeting drag performances and events, the Sacramento Rainbow Chamber of Commerce (RCC) has hired private, unarmed, uniformed security guards for its Drag Queen Bingo event, held monthly at Mango's. RCC acknowledges the harassment, violence, and harm law enforcement agencies have historically inflicted upon our LGBTQ+ community and communities of color, at large. We are sharing this information out of transparency and respect for our community, while still maintaining necessary precautions for the safety for all DQB event attendees, volunteers, and staff. We will continue to monitor threat risk and will reevaluate as needed. Thank you for your understanding while we navigate these challenging times. Please stay safe, and we hope to still see you on the first Thursday of every month at Drag Queen Bingo!
