#### A Year of Innovation, Impact, and Pride

As 2024 draws to a close, we are excited to celebrate the remarkable milestones we've achieved together. Thanks to the incredible support of our members, sponsors, and partners, this year has been one for the books!

#### By the Numbers:

**Membership:** 334 members and 30 major partnerships representing a diverse network of small businesses, corporations, and allies.

#### Scholarships:

- \$17,500 awarded to Rainbow Chamber Foundation Scholarship recipients.
- \$4,500 in Culinary Arts Scholarships.
- \$2,000 awarded to **Health Care Residents** to support debt relief.

Philanthropy: Drag Queen Bingo has donated over \$21,923 in 2024, benefitting 12 nonprofit organizations annually and adding to a cumulative \$490,000+ since 2010.

#### Highlights from 2024:

**Engaging Events**: Signature gatherings like the **Boa's and Bow Ties Gala** and **Farm 2 Scholar** brought the community together to celebrate and raise critical funds.

Networking Mixers: 12 mixers provided space for collaboration and impactful discussions.

**Supporting Local Businesses**: Through advocacy, workshops, and networking, we've empowered LGBTQ-owned and allied businesses across Sacramento to thrive.

**Empowering the Next Generation:** Scholarships programs helped **18** LGBTQ+ and allied students achieve their academic dreams.

**Media Reach:** Our e-blasts reached 12,000+ contacts, and stories of our work were widely shared across LGBTQ+ media platform, Outword Magazine, and local outlets such as the Sacramento Business Journal and ABC 10.


This event will bring together business and community leaders to celebrate excellence in advancing LGBTQ+ inclusion, diversity, equity, and belonging.




### LGBTQ+ foster youth need advocates like you!

A 2019 study found that 30.4% of youth in foster care identify as LGBTQ+ and 5% as transgender, compared to 11.2% and 1.17% of youth not in foster care.

44% of LGBTQ+ youth in state custody report they were removed, ran away, or were thrown out of their home for reasons directly related to their identity.

Once in the system, LGBTQ+ youth in foster care are at higher risk of additional harms, including discrimination, institutionalization, and abuse. They are more likely to age out without finding a permanent family home.



"My youth asked, "Would you be weirded out by me if I was queer?" In response, I simply said, "No. I'm queer too. Are you weirded out by me?" The look of surprise mingled with comfort on their face remains etched in my memory.

"As their CASA, I made it my mission to advocate fiercely for their rights, not only as a foster youth, but also as a queer youth, ensuring that their preferred name and pronouns were respected in every court report and hearing. I empowered them to embrace their authentic self, advocating for gender-affirming care and providing support every step of the way."

Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) Sacramento was established in 1991 with the mission to ensure consistency and support for children in the foster care system in Sacramento County through the use of volunteer advocates, advancing the best interests of each child. Our vision is that every child in need is appointed a CASA to champion them in Court, without compromise, on the path to a safe and permanent home.

CASA Volunteers provide support, mentorship, and advocacy for young people who through no fault of their own have been removed from their parent's care due to abuse or neglect. A big

piece of that work involves advocating for the youth in what are often complex court proceedings that they would otherwise have to negotiate on their own.

CASA support for youth is vital for maintaining placements, accessing services, and benefiting from educational offerings. CASA Volunteers monitor the health and safety of younger children, including their access to nutrition and housing security, and help older youth access resources and navigate benefits systems like CalFresh. CASA Volunteers write reports to the dependency judge and make recommendations to increase or decrease family visits, to change or remain in a school or educational program, to push for adoption, reunification, or to explore familial connections for possible placement. Every CASA Volunteer is an educational advocate and many are their youth's legal educational rights holder.

At any given time, we are only serving about 15% of Sacramento's youth in foster care, leaving hundreds of kids in the system without a trusted adult to advocate for their needs. 
