
### We cannot stay silent. Silence is complicity.



### Eligibility:

To qualify, a business must:

· Be at least 51% owned by individuals who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer/questioning or other LGBTQ+ identities
· Be headquartered in Sacramento, Yolo, Placer or El Dorado County

There is **no fee** to participate, and inclusion in the list is free. Please note that the Sacramento Business Journal reserves the right to edit or omit submissions for publication.




