programs that may help pay for medication and services (must qualify per state guidelines). We accept most insurance plans.

Participants must bring physical or digital copies of the following to receive certification, either on USB or device.

- Laptop (tablets and cellphones are usually too small for the process)
- Internal Revenue Service letter issuing Employer Identification Number (EIN)
- Federal tax returns for the last 3 years or for the period of time your business has been operational if less than 3 years.
- Personal federal tax returns for the last 3 years if your business is a sole proprietorship.
- California Employment Development Department Forms DE-9C records for the 4 most recent quarters
- Licenses (if applicable), such as business license, CSLB, resellers permit, etc.

- · Legal entity documents
 - o Sole proprietorship/partnership
 - o Fictitious business name statement
 - o Partnership agreement (if applicable)
- · LLC
 - o Articles of Organization
 - o Statement of Information
 - o Operating Agreement
- Corporation
 - o Articles of Incorporation
 - o Statement of Information
 - o Corporate Bylaws and Amendments
 - Most recent copy of corporate meeting minutes showing election of officers

(In some cases, additional documentation may be required to complete certification.)


